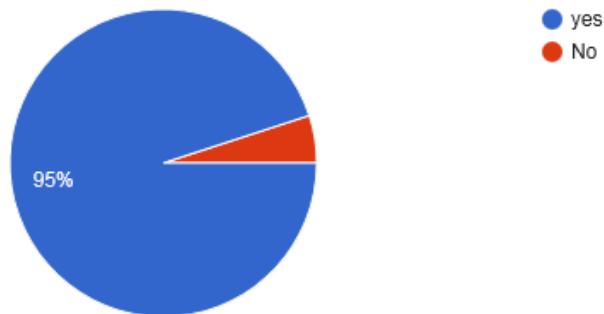

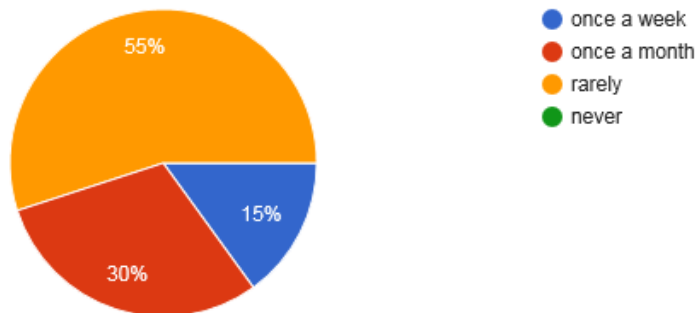
1. Have you ever taken part Learning Outside the Classroom-activities?

Answered :20



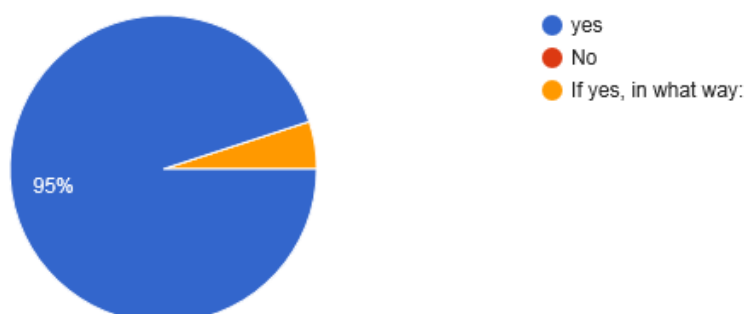
2. How often are Learning Outside the Classroom-activities organized in your school?

Answered: 20



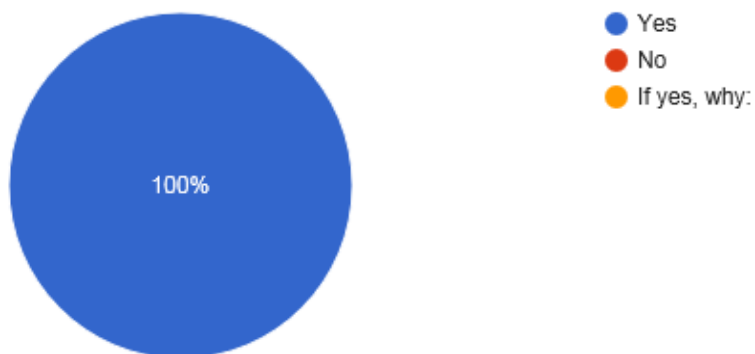
3. Do you think that Outside Classroom Learning Activities benefit your learning?

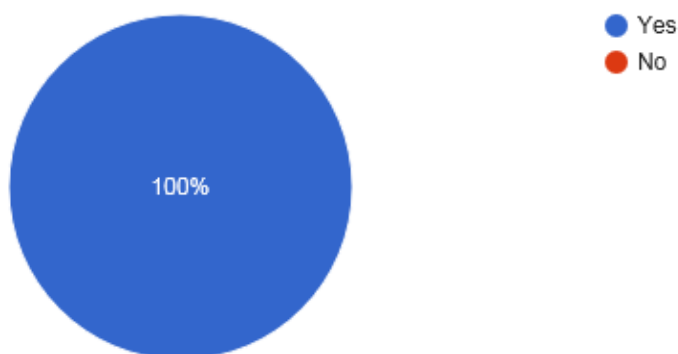
4. Do you think it's important to offer Learning Outside the Classroom opportunities for pupils?
